"Fintrol (the toric agent) acts on the nervous system of fish, causing construction of blood vessels in the gills which results in suffocation," said Ron Spitter, district fisheries biologist. "The concentration used is very specific for small (less than five-inch) fish and will leave all larger gamelish intact, if not fatter from feeding on the dvine panelish.

"The thinning concept is likened to weeding a garden. The remaining crops grow bigger, stater — in this case re-sulting in a healthier fishery.

"Fish affected by the treatment will die within several days, providing much food for other fish, crayfish, tur-les, gulls and ducks. A few. carcasses may litter windolown shorelines for a few days but, due to the small size and the time of year, should not cause more
