Korea. A 1980 study found these vets more likely to suffer later health problems because many endured starvation diets, lack of medical care and inhumane treatment while in captivity.

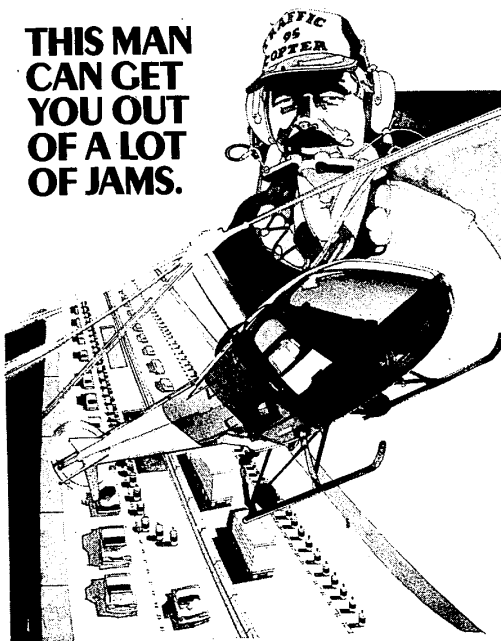
