Camp for diabetic kids is taking registrations

Camp Midicha, a summer facility for diabetic children and teen-agers, begins its 28th consecutive season this year with a six-week camp in the Lower Peninsula and a 10-day camp in the Upper Peninsula.

The American Diabetes Association-Michigan affiliated is the sponsor of the program at Tau Beta Camp at Columbusville, northeast of Flint.

Four sessions are scheduled, June 27-July 3 for ages 6-10; July 4-17 for ages 8-12; July 18-24 for ages 11-14; and July 25-Aug. 7 for ages 12-16.

The ADA camps give young diabetics a taste of camp life — swimming, canoeing, overnight, campfires, crafts and nature study. They also get help in dealing with emotional, social and medical reactions to being diabetic. Doctors and nurses on staff, many of them diabetics, take care of any physical problems that may arise and also serve as role models for the youngsters.

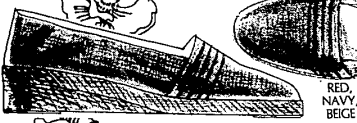
