Enforcement and Project.
"It is a great pleasure to be able to report that the rate of reduction of alcohol-related traffic accidents is now running 21 percent below the base years," Steed-said. "This means that the county experience at least 1,7000 fewer accidents, almost half of which would have bein to the fatal or personal injury category.

"JUST OVER \$400,000 of federal dollars had been put into the project, but because of the accident reduction, the savings in economic costs is well over \$8.5 million," she




