by escaped slave Josiah Henson. He is known to the world as Uncle Torn because he was the basis for that character in the novel. "Uncle Torn's Cabin" by Harriet Beecher Stowe.

The property includes a gift shop, small museum, the restored two-story house in which Henson lived and one of the two-story homes which once lived streets in this area, serving as temporary homes for runaway slaves.

The colony functioned for 30 years as a home and raining ground for runaway slaves until the emancipation of slaves in the United States after the Civil War.
