

'Annie' on screen opens at benefit premiere

The gala metropolitan-Detroit premiere of the movie "Annie" will be held at 8 p.m. June 17 at the Americana Theatre in Southfield.

The premiere will be part of the largest individual fund-raising event in the history of public television, with proceeds from the benefit going to support children's programming on WTWS, Channel 56, in Detroit.

Local celebrities will attend opening night, joined by a local Daddy Warbucks, FDR and Sandy, and a chorus of singing and dancing Annies. A camera crew and interviewer will be on hand to film the special guests and celebrities as they arrive for the premiere showing.

Afterward, all will party under a festive tent on the Americana grounds where there will be champagne, a "Gala des Bon Bons" (with lavish

sweets tables) and music for dancing.

PREFERRED DRESS that evening is red and white for women and black for men, except members of the "red tie committee" who will wear red ties. (The red tie committee, a group of 170 Detroit-area citizens, has been at work for many weeks coordinating the sale of 1,600 premiere party tickets priced at \$50.)

An intensified experience in theater skills awaits high-school and college students this summer at Cranbrook Summer Theatre School, which is accepting enrollment for its 41st consecutive season.

The program, opening June 21, offers eight weeks of daily (9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., Mondays-Fridays) acting and instruction under the direction of a professional staff.

Each student appears weekly in a speaking role, in a short play, as well as a major three-act production. Classes

The school offers two special programs for students 12th grade and older. One permits them to take the course for credit by arrangement with their schools. The second provides tuition apprenticeships in acting for boys, in technical work for boys and girls, and in wardrobe management for girls.
