**CITY OF FARMINGTON HILLS
SUMMARY OF PROCEEDINGS
CITY COUNCIL MEETING
June 21, 1982**

Mayor Burwell opened the Special City Council Meeting of the City of Farmington Hills on June 21, 1982, at 7:33 p.m. Members present were: Burwell, Dolan, Lange, Sorocsa, Williams and Wolfe. Absent: Hughes.

Others present were: Assistant City Manager Costick, City Clerk Cairns, Director of Public Services Biassell, City Attorney Poehlman and Planning Consultants Coates.

The agenda was approved with the addition of Item 8c, to go into Executive Session regarding litigation following the meeting.

Council approved introduction of Zoning Map Amendment C22-258 (ZR-PC-25-9-81) to rezone land on the south side of Thirteen Mile Road, between Middlebelt and Davis Lane from RA-1A to RA-1B.

Council approved introduction of Zoning Map Amendment C22-282 (ZR 4-3-82) to rezone property at 38285 Twelve Mile Road from RA-1 to OS-1.

Council approved road improvement for Greencastle Subdivision, Resolutions No. 3, No. 4 and No. 6, setting the Public Hearing date for July 12, 1982.

Council introduced ordinance to establish Natural Beauty Roads.

Council approved Resolution opposing Senate Bill 2172 and Senate Bill 2445.

Meeting adjourned at 10:27 p.m.

PUBLIC NOTICE**

The City of Farmington Hills Summer 1982 Tax Statements are payable from July 1, 1982 through August 31, 1982. 4% penalty added on September 1, 1982, plus 1/8% interest per month on unpaid balance.

City Hall Office will be open for payment of taxes 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday with the following exception:

Monday, July 5, 1982, closed all day.

For taxpayers convenience, a night depository, located on the east wall of the front courtyard, is available for after hours tax payments. Also, tax payments may be made at any National Bank of Detroit. They will accept tax payments until 3:00 p.m., August 31, 1982.

Whether you pay your taxes in person, through the mail, or by night depository, be sure to return BOTH COPIES of the tax bill.

Applications for deferment of 1982 taxes will be available at the City of Farmington Hills Treasurer's Office. If your income for 1981 did not exceed \$10,000 and you are a paraplegic, quadriplegic, senior citizen, eligible serviceman, eligible veteran, eligible widow, blind or totally or permanently disabled, your application must be filed with the City of Farmington Hills Treasurer's Office no later than September 15, 1982.

Summer taxes that are deferred will be payable along with winter taxes no later than Monday, February 14, 1983.

By law, PAYMENTS BY MAIL are recorded by the Treasurer on the date actually received. Payments received after August 31, 1982, will be returned with added penalty.
