

Hagen tourney slated

Local teenage golfers will have an opportunity July 28 to gain valuable tournament experience by competing in the American Cancer Society's Junior Walter Hagen Golf Tournament at Glen Oaks Golf & Country Club in Farmington.

The tournament in Farmington is just one of five such junior tournaments being staged at various golf clubs that week.

Art Link, chairman of the tournaments and golfing coach at Abbot Middle School, Orchard Lake, said the tournament will feature two divisions, the Golden Masters for males and females 16-18 years of age and the Masters Division for males and females 13-15 years of age.

Junior Walter Hagen tournaments are not only for the avid golfer, but also for those who play occasionally," Link said.

There is a \$20 entry fee for the tournament. The fee includes 18 holes of golf and bag tags.

The top three golfers in each division will have the opportunity to advance to the Metro Detroit Championship playoffs at Salem Hills Golf Club in Northville on August 2. Championship winners may compete at the State Hagen Finals in Ann Arbor.

Tucker sets two records Beechview sunk by Forest Hills

Beechview Swim Club of Farmington Hills was edged out of its second victory of the young season Thursday night by Forest Hills Swim Club of Birmingham, 288-280. On June 18, Beechview defeated the swim club from Lathrup Village 295-274 in the opening meet of the Northwest Suburban Swim League A Division.

Elizabeth Tucker broke two records Thursday, including her own breaststroke record she set the week before. In the 8-year-olds and under division, Tucker set a new record in the butterfly (1:22.21) and then broke her previous record in the breaststroke (2:21.21).

Six Beechview swimmers were double winners in individual events. In 11-12, Kirk Taylor won the backstroke (37.46) and the IM (1:22.09). Mary Wik took the freestyle (33.15) and the IM (1:26.03). Scott Farabee captured the freestyle (31.99) and the butterfly (36.80).

In the 13-14 division, Mike Valvona won the IM (1:12.63) and the breaststroke (36.19). Nancy Schwedt captured the freestyle (32.22) and also the backstroke (41.50). Paula King won the butterfly (33.07) and then went up to the 15-17 bracket and again won the butterfly (32.33).

In 13-14, Paula King captured the butterfly (33.07) and Diana Raddatz took the freestyle (31.6). In 15-17, Helen Tucker won the freestyle (1:12.73).

Relay firsts were in the 40-year girls with E. Tucker, M. Quinn, M. Spear and Lynn Brown (1:07.05); the 52-year boys with K. Taylor, M. Valvona, S. Farabee and M. McDonald (2:21.1); and in the boys 64-year relay with M. Wik, J. Abunassar, S. Goodman and K. Raddatz (1:53.52).

The City of Farmington Hills Summer 1982 Tax Statements are payable from July 1, 1982 through August 31, 1982 4% penalty added on September 1, 1982 plus 1/2% interest per month on unpaid balance.

City Hall Office will be open for payment of taxes 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday with the following exception:

Monday, July 5, 1982, Closed all day.

For taxpayers convenience, a night depository, located on the east wall of the front courtyard, is available for after hours tax payments. Also, tax payments may be made at any National Bank of Detroit. They will accept tax payments until 3:00 p.m., August 31, 1982.

Whether you pay your taxes in person, through the mail, or by night depository, be sure to return BOTH COPIES of the tax bill.

Applications for deferment of 1982 taxes will be available at the City of Farmington Hills Treasurer's Office. If your income for 1981 did not exceed \$10,000 and you are a paraplegic, quadriplegic, senior citizen, eligible serviceman, eligible veteran, eligible widow, blind or totally or permanently disabled, your application must be filed with the City of Farmington Hills Treasurer's Office no later than September 15, 1982. Summer taxes that are deferred will be payable along with winter taxes no later than Monday, February 14, 1983.

By law, PAYMENTS BY MAIL are recorded by the Treasurer on the date actually received. Payments received after August 31, 1982, will be returned with added penalty.
