# How to save water and keep yard green

We have just received notice that our water bill will be going up 49.5 percent. Our biggest bills are in the summer when we water our lawn and garden. How can we cut down and not sacrifice our yard?

Water your lawn and garden only when it really needs it. Early morning and late evening are the best times to water most lawn areas. Give the lawn a good deep soaking, light sprinklings evaporate too quickly.

Don't water the pavement and the sewer. Direct sprinklers to prevent watering cement, street and driveways. Never water on windy days. Check for leaks in hoses, faucets and couplings.

I seems that everyone has a abundance of zucchini. The good news is

that it is very versatile and freezes well. What you don't use fresh can be grated and frozen in usable portions. Frozen zucchini is terrific for use in quick bread, or mixed with beaten eggs or added to soups and casseroles.
