

Woodbrooke tankers win

Scott Stinson, Cindy Cramer and Kristin Kranz each shattered a pool record last week as Farmington Hills Woodbrooke Hills raised its record to 3-1 with a 311-250 victory over Southfield Pinebrook in the Northwest Suburban Swimming League.

Stinson, swimming in the boys' 13-14 age group, set a record in 100 individual medley (1:10.91). Cramer earned her record by going 38.66 in the 11-12 50-meter breaststroke, and Kranz notched hers by going 1:14.25 in the same 100 IM in the same age group.

Kranz was a double winner, taking the 11-12 50 butterfly (33.55), and Jennie Morton the 50 backstroke (38.14) and the 50 freestyle (30.81) in the same age group.

In the boys' 11-12 group, Jim McCaffrey won the 100 IM (2:28.49) and the 50 backstroke (44.41). Marge Cramer was a double winner in the girls' 13-14 group, posting times of 39.1 in the 50 breaststroke and 20.35 in the 50 freestyle. Dave Anderson, swimming in the boys' 13-14, took the

50 backstroke (35.77) and the 50 free (28.45). Woodbrooke had two double winners in the 15-17 group. Dan Wery won the 50 breast (37.17) and the 100 IM (1:13.59), and Chris Leslie finished first in the boys' 50 breast (36.07) and the 100 IM (1:11.8).

Woodbrooke also won five relay events. In the boys' 64-year freestyle relay, Stinson teamed with Bill Spicer, Eric Kramp and Leslie to go 1:52.85. The girls' 64 free relay (Jennifer Rowe, Coleen Carey, Andries and Kranz) was timed in 2:03.13.

Morton, Cindy Cramer, Marge Cramer and Kathy Pirog made up the girls' 52-year medley relay, which won with a time of 2:25.81. The boys' 40-year freestyle (McCaffrey, Scott Mayotte, Keith Lee and Joe Hewitt) won in 1:07.91, and the girls' 40-year free relay (Karrie Kranz, Michelle McCaffrey, Heather Siles and Liz Worthen) won in 1:07.53.

dual meet, 323-255.

Two Beechview relays established team records. The 52-year boys' medley team (Mike McDonald, Mike Valvona, Kirk Taylor and Scott Farabee) set a record with a 2:17.19 clocking. The 64 girls' freestyle team (Diana Radatka, Maureen Kelly, Nancy Whitmore and Paula King) placed second but set a record with a time of 2:01.67.

Farabee, Taylor, Andrew Fitzpatrick and Elizabeth Tucker were double winners for Beechview. Farabee finished first in the 11-12 IM (2:17.75) and the butterfly (37.43). Taylor won the backstroke (36.82) and the freestyle (31.56) in the same age group.

Fitzpatrick took the 7-8 freestyle (21.57) and the backstroke (22.88). Tucker, swimming in the girls' 7-8, won the backstroke (21.53) and the breaststroke (29.59).

Heart of the Hills' Dan Wery established a pool record in the 15-17 breaststroke with a time of 33.52. Four other Heart of the Hills swimmers shattered pool records in the meet.

Even the sixth-graders at Washington Elementary are excited about their teacher and favor what she does. Johns said she emphasizes the physical fitness aspect — rather than the posing and contests — of body building to her students.

"These 10 to 12 pounds I've put on have helped tremendously. I should be a lot higher in weight. I'm going to see what happens if I keep on going with it. I hope I can put on some more weight without artificial means."

CITY COUNCIL MEETING
July 12, 1982

Mayor Burwell opened the regular meeting of the City Council of Farmington Hills on July 12, 1982, at 7:35 P.M. Members present were Burwell, DeLano, Lange, Hughes, Williams and Wolf. Absent: Sorenson. Others present were City Manager Savage, Assistant City Manager Costick, City Clerk Cairns, Director of Public Services Biswell and City Attorney Bibeau.

The minutes of June 28, 1982 were approved with one correction.

The agenda was approved with the addition of two items: 10b. Consideration of Wadestorer flooding problems and 11.d. Consideration of an executive session.

Council confirmed the roll for Greenacres Subdivision road improvement Special Assessment District C-165 and passed pending Resolution No. 7.

Council approved the demolition of the buildings at 28104 Farmington Road.

Council enacted Zoning Map Amendment C62-282 to rezone the property at 38265 Twelve Mile Road from RA-1 to OS.

Council approved adding lot 102 of Tarabusi Grand River Gardens Subdivision from Special Assessment District C-165 to Lots 103 and 104 as one unit and combining Lots 105 and 106 as one unit.

Council discussed the problem of flooding at the residence of the Wadestorers at 32001 West 12 Mile Road.

The proposed sidewalk assessment policy was tabled to July 26th for time to draft policy on maintenance.

The financing of Thirteen Mile Road sidewalks was tabled to July 26th.

Council introduced Ordinance C-19-82 to provide for ordinance for handicapped parking in shopping centers in the City.

Council approved an executive session following the meeting.
