The ordinance was enacted based on neighbors' repeated complaints about the restaurant in its previous incarnations, first the Landmark restaurant and later the Green Onion. The neighbors said customers arriving after the bars closed were keeping them awake by being loud and rowdy. Council members present at Monday's meeting reportedly were receptive to changing the ordinance but wanted to defer votting on the matter until councilment Raiph Yoder and William Mitchell returned from vacation.

The Glass Onion restaurant was burned by an arsonist June 15, 1991—a crime that remains unsolved.




