Heritage Home Tour tickets on sale now

The Historical Commissions of the cities of Farmington and Farmington Hills will present their first combined Heritage Home Tour Oct. 2 and 3.

The tour will feature 16 of the area's houses and buildings dating from 1827-1900 and will include the new Farmington Historical Museum, the former home of Michigan's governor from 1905 to 1910, Fred M. Warner.

Advanced tickets are on sale at \$7 each in Farmington City Hall, Farmington Hills City Hall, the Farmington Historical Museum, the Farmington Chamber of Commerce and the Farmington Community Center.
