

Detroit Concert Band to play at Greenmead

The idyllic setting of historic Greenmead will provide the backdrop when the "Great American Concert Band" comes to Livonia Sunday, Aug. 29 to wind up the outdoor summer music series sponsored by the Livonia Arts Commission.

The "Great American Concert Band" is the Detroit Concert Band headed by Mr. Music himself, Leonard B. Smith, cornet/trumpet virtuoso, composer, author and music educator.

For 36 years, Smith has presided over the band's rise to international eminence for its role in carrying out the classical heritage of John Philip Sousa.

THE BAND'S appearance at Greenmead, Livonia's 200-acre historical site at Eight Mile and Newburgh roads, marks a first.

The band has traditionally closed the summer music series with a concert at Ford Field to accommodate the large number of concertgoers. But with the ongoing improvement of Greenmead facilities — particularly for parking — coupled with the success of several other recent musical events held there, the Historical Commission was prompted to request that the concert location be switched.

"The arts commission agreed that Greenmead is a natural setting for the kind of concert the Detroit band is famous for," said commission mem-

ber Shirley Bishop. To promote an atmosphere of an old-fashioned concert in the park, the Historical Commission will sponsor an ice cream social prior to the concert. The social will run from 3-5:30 p.m. with the concert starting shortly thereafter.

"BESIDES BEING the ideal spot for the concert," said Bishop, "the commission had another reason for suggesting the switch in locations. We want to use every means available to get the community out to Greenmead to see first-hand its beauty and resources."

In honor of the day, the commission is waiving its normal museum admission fee and also will have the restored DNR building and the blacksmith shop in the historic village open for public inspection.

There is no admission charge for the concert. No-charge parking will be provided at Newburgh Road with the entrance prominently marked. Police reservists will assist in the parking operations.

Concertgoers are advised to wear comfortable shoes for the picturesque stroll from the parking lot to the concert area.

In the event of rain, the concert will go on as scheduled at Churchill High School, but there will be no ice cream social.

The Livonia DCB performance is funded by the Ford Motor Co.-Livonia-Redford Community Relations Committee.

Seminary to offer classes

Individual courses may be taken for enrichment or be applied to a degree program. SS. Cyril and Methodius Seminary grants master of divinity and master of religious education degrees. It also offers a one-year certificate in pastoral ministry for those who wish to update their theology and prepare for a church-related ministry.
