Driver faces four gun charges

A North Carolina man was charged with four felony counts last Wednesday after allegedly pulling a handgun on a state trooper who pulled over to ask him why he was parked on the side of Eight Mile at Farmington Hills' western border.

Troopers pulled up behind a parked 1977 Toyota driven by Jerry Roberts, 35, of Julian, N.C., and "asked if they could be of assistance," said Trooper Robert Garcia, State Police spokesman. Roberts reportedly replied that he was having engine trouble.

When troopers Gary Nix and Cliff

Cushard asked Roberts to produce identification, he told law enforcement officials they had no business harassing him, Garcia said.

A bag of bullets was spotted between the two front seats, according to Garcia, while Roberts was fumbling around for his identification. Troopers claim Roberts reached into the pocket of a jacket lying next to him and pulled out a revolver, but dropped the gun when it hit the gearshift knob.

Troopers said their guns were drawn

but no gunfire was exchanged.

In 47th District Court the following day, Roberts was charged with felonious assault, use of a firearm in commission of a felony, and two counts of carrying concealed weapons — a loaded .44-caliber Remington revolver and a .22-caliber blue steel automatic pistol.

Roberts pleaded innocent and was released after posting 10 percent of a \$2,000 bond. A preliminary exam is set for Sept. 9 in the case.
