Now that spring is here, summer camp is not far behind. This year, at least 14 Torch Drive services will have camp programs for residents of Wayne, Oakland and Macomb counties.

And it's not too soon to bring out the brochures and start making plans and reservations.

Don't think either that you won't be able to go to camp because you don't have the money or you have some kind of handicap. The benefits of the outdoors are still available through special programs for needy families, senior citizens, and the handicapped.

Plan now for some summer fun.

Torch Drive camps for children include:

BOYS CLUBS of Metropolitan Detroit -- Camp Drusilla Farwell on Harsen's Island is open to boys aged 10 to 16. Rates are \$45 for 12 days of camping. The man to contact is Charles Steffes at 3826 Livernois, Detroit, 48210.

BOYS SCOUTS, Detroit Area Council -- Scouts between the ages of 11 and 18 can go to the D-Bar-A Scout Ranch at Metamora, and Charles Howell Scout Reservation at Brighton, Hille River Scout Camp Base in Alger or the Silver Lake Scout Camp at Indian River. Rates vary with the facilities, from \$7.50 for six days of tenting to \$70 for 13 days of camp. Contact: Boy Scout headquarters, 1776 West Warren, 48208.

CAMP FIRE Girls -- Camp Wathana in Holly is open to girls 7 to 17. For 10 days members pay \$60, non-members \$65. Information available at the Camp Fire Girls office, 51 West Warren, Detroit, 48201.

CATHOLIC YOUTH Organization -- CYO operates separate camps for boys and girls aged 9 to 14, both at Lake Huron. Rates for each camp is \$75 for 13 days. Information is available at the CYO office, 305 Michigan, Detroit, 48226.

FRESH AIR SOCIETY -- Camp Tamarack at Brighton is open to children aged 8 to 10 and Camp Tamarack at Grosse Pointe is open to children 11 to 16. At least one parent must be Jewish to qualify. Rates vary from \$140 to \$219 for 19 days, depending on ability to pay. The society also offers a four-week camp and a camp in Ontario. Information on all is available at the society office, 18277 Schaeffer Highway, Detroit, 48235.

GIRL SCOUTS of Metropolitan Detroit -- Camp Inlandree on Bentley Lake at Pinckney costs \$55 per troop per week. Camp Metamora on Otiskita Lake, Metamora, costs \$60 for a girl for two weeks, \$65 for non-members. Both are open to girls aged 9 to 18. Girl Scouts get first crack at reservations, but after June 1 reservations are opened to non-members. Information at 153 East Elizabeth, Detroit, 48201.

YMCA -- Camp Ojibwa at Fish Lake, Holly, is for boys and girls aged 8 to 11, and Camp Nissokone, Van Etan Lake, Oscoda, for boys and girls aged 12 to 17. Rate is \$115 for 12-day period. Contact the nearest YMCA branch for information.

YWCA -- Camp Cavell at Lake Huron, Lexington, is for girls in the fourth through twelfth grades. Rate is \$75 for 12 days. Camp Cavell office is at 2230 Witherell, Detroit, 48201.

OU Will Honor Varner

Durward B. Varner, chancellor of the University of Nebraska, will return to the institution he guided for its first decade when he delivers the April 25 commencement address at Oakland University.

A highlight of Varner's "homecoming" will be the conferring on him of an honorary L.H.U. degree by OU Chancellor Donald D. O'Dowd. O'Dowd succeeded Varner at OU February 1.

There are 577 candidates for academic degrees in the seventh spring commencement which will be held at 3:00 p.m. in the sports and recreation building.

They include 435 candidates for the B.A. degree, 32 candidates for the B.S. degree and 90 candidates for masters' degrees.

The ceremony will probably be the last in which OU degrees are conferred in conjunction with Michigan State University. OU has served as a branch campus university since opening in 1959, but pending legislation would separate the school effective July, 1970.

It was in 1957 that the late Mr. and Mrs. Alfred G. Wilson first approached then MSU President John Hannah with a gift of \$2 million in cash and their 1,300-acre Meadow Brook Farms Estate for the purpose of opening a new university. Varner, then an MSU vice president, was given the job of heading the new institution which was first known briefly as MSU-Oakland and then as Oakland University.

During its first decade, Oakland grew from 520 students to its current record enrollment of 5,925 and it has received national recognition for its academic program and for its Meadow Brook Festival and Theatre and other commitments in the performing arts.
