

Night classes available for community education

The Ten Mile Community School has launched another season of evening classes.

Classes begin the week of Sept. 20. Interested persons may register either by mail or in person at the Ten Mile School, 32789 10 Mile, Farmington 48024.

Registration is from 8:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. or from 7-9 p.m., Monday-Thursday. Fees are payable at the time of registration. Mail registrants should plan on attending the class at the first meeting. No further notification will be given.

Refunds will be granted when classes are cancelled. All other requests must be made to the Community Education Office before the second class meeting. A \$2 registration fee will be deducted in the case of withdrawal.

Persons 60 and older are eligible for one free registration except in limited enrollment classes (indicated by an *). Identification from the school must be obtained prior to registration.

Following is a partial list of the evening classes, their times and tuition. Classes are eight weeks unless otherwise indicated.

INTRODUCTION TO PROGRAMMING IN BASIC LANGUAGE* — Harrison High School, Wednesday, 7-9 p.m., Room 391, \$20. An introductory course to the use and programming of the new microcomputer. Radio Shack TRS-80s used. For adults only. Limited enrollment.

SPEED READING AND COMPREHENSION SKILLS — Farmington

High School, Wednesday, 7-9 p.m., Room 212B, \$20. Designed to help the individual improve his reading rate, concentration, vocabulary, critical comprehension, class discussion, practice with visual aids, reading selections with comprehension checks.

DRIVER EDUCATION FOR ADULTS* — For adults, 18 or older. Behind-the-wheel instruction in a dual controlled car. Individualized schedules arranged. Call 477-1300, Ext. 26 for information.

AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE — Monday, 7:30-9:30 p.m., Room 1, \$20. Learn the basics of manual communication in American Sign Language. Course is designed for parents, teachers, professionals and anyone who is interested in bridging the communication gap that exists among the hearing impaired.

PHOTOGRAPHY I (6 weeks) — Wednesday, 7-9 p.m., Room 6, \$20. An introductory course that deals with the fundamentals of the camera, exposure, focusing, motion, depth of field, lenses and filters. Course will include two field trips.

BRIDGE, BEGINNERS — Tuesday, 7-9:30 p.m., Room 10, \$22. Course for beginners covering hand counting, deal, auction and bidding. Playing of hands interspersed with instruction to assist in absorption of instruction and to aid in gaining playing experience.

BRIDGE INTERMEDIATE — Monday, 7-9:30 p.m., Room 4, \$22. Course in

play of specially prepared hands for those who have had beginners course and/or playing experience. Play preceded by rapid review of bidding fundamentals, lead, play, defense, instruction, and instruction of certain bidding conventions.

MONEY MYSTIQUE — Farmington High School, four weeks, Monday, 7-9 p.m., Room 110E, \$10. Taught by a certified financial planner. Most effective use of money discussed. MACHINE SHOP* — Farmington High, Thursday, 7-10 p.m., Room 106G, \$25. Class provides instruction in various machines including vertical mills, surface grinding and lathes.

GUN SAFETY* — Four weeks, Tuesday, 7-9 p.m., Room 5, \$5. Course includes: basic facts about firearms and ammunition; distinguishing and operating various firearms; responsibilities of the firearms owner. Limited enrollment.

TYPING, BEGINNING — Monday, 7-9:30 p.m., Room 2, \$22. Basic intro-

ductory course. Drill on speed and accuracy. Textbook extra.

TYPING, INTERMEDIATE — Wednesday, 7-9:30 p.m., Room 2, \$22. Intermediate and advanced students. Drills on speed and accuracy. Includes work on typing letters, tabulations and reports. Electric typewriters. Textbook extra.

GREGG SHORTHAND, BEGINNERS — Thursday, 7-9 p.m., Room 3, \$20. You will give the fundamentals of Gregg Shorthand and dictation. Textbook extra.

GREGG SHORTHAND REFRESHER — Tuesday, 7-9 p.m., Room 3, \$20. For persons who previously had Gregg Shorthand. A review of shorthand theory and brief forms. Learn to increase your speed and dictation. Bring shorthand notebook and paper. Textbook extra.

SHORTHAND A-B-C STENOGRAPHY — Farmington High, Monday and Wednesday, 7:30-9:30 p.m., Room 106C, \$40. Stenography, the easy-to-learn shorthand system written with the abc's. No symbols to learn. Learn to take dictation at 80-100 words per minute by the end of the course. Textbook extra.

ACCOUNTING AND BOOKKEEPING I — Monday, 7-9 p.m., Room 7,

\$20. The fundamentals of bookkeeping and principles of accounting procedures. Textbook extra.

ACCOUNTING AND BOOKKEEPING II — Thursday, 7-9 p.m., Room 7, \$20. A continuation of the Accounting and Bookkeeping I class.

FRENCH I, CONVERSATIONAL — Thursday, 7-9 p.m., Room 5, \$20. Basic vocabulary taught to students and would-be travelers with no previous exposure to French. Introduction to menu reading, the French culture, etc.

FRENCH II AND III, CONVERSATIONAL — Wednesday, 7-9 p.m., Room 9, \$20. A continuation of French I and for those students having previous exposure to the French language. Study materials will be adapted to the abilities of the class members with emphasis on self-expression.

SPANISH I, CONVERSATIONAL — Monday, 7-9 p.m., Room 3, \$20. This course is designed to give the student a knowledge of the fundamentals of conversational Spanish. For beginners. Textbook extra.

ADVANCED SPANISH, CONVERSATIONAL — Tuesday, 7-9 p.m.,

Room 9, \$20. For those who have completed Spanish I or have an equivalent knowledge of Spanish.

CHINESE COOKING* — Tuesday, 7-9 p.m., Kitchen, \$25. Cut, marinate and season your way to a variety of Chinese dishes. Instruction in the use of chopsticks and other Chinese utensils will be given. Learn to cook and taste dishes from four regions of China. Materials fee extra.

MICROWAVE COOKING* — (4 weeks) Learn all you ever wanted to know about your microwave oven. Recipes demonstrated will range from simple to gourmet. Materials fee of \$10 due instructor at first session. Class I, Wednesday, beginning Sept. 22, 7-9 p.m., Kitchen, \$12 or Class II, Thursday, beginning Sept. 23 for beginning students, 7-9 p.m., Kitchen, \$12.

DRAWING AND INTRODUCTION TO PAINTING — Thursday, 7-9 p.m., Room 1, \$20. A class on drawing as a means of observation and basis of art. Basic drawing materials will be explored and may be expanded into painting techniques according to the student's desire. Bring to first class: 14" x 17" newspaper pad and soft drawing pencils. Painting materials to be discussed as needed.
