The state Court of Appeals fails to act—or acts unfavorably from SEMTA's point of view—in a case brought by the Oakland County Road Commission. Some \$21 million in tricounty vehicle license surcharge and title transfer taxes are tied up in an excrow account until the suit is settled.

The Michigan Legislature fails for the second straight year to fulfill a 1977 promise to adopt a comprehensive transportation package. Lawmakers dodged the issue this year because ralaing taxes has been such an unpopular issue.


