Smelt Runs Coming Up

Smelt runs in Lake Huron and Lake Michigan should be well under way during April's third week, according to a report from the Michigan Department of Natural Resources.

Predictions are that last year's successful season will be matched this spring in Lake Huron's Tawas River and Whitney Drain, and in the Manistique and Charlevoix areas of Lake Michigan.

The silvery fish move into rivers and streams when water temperatures reach 43 degrees, say department biologists. Generally, the spawning season extends over a four to five-week period.
