

Talent is plentiful on All-Area football squad

mates and was a leader by example," Southfield coach John Finlayson said. "He was one of the hardest hitting linebackers we've had at Southfield High."

CHRIS KOOLWICK, a 6-2, 195-pound linebacker, had 72 tackles, two fumble recoveries and two interceptions for LaSalle. He also blocked an extra point in overtime against Groves.

"Chris was the heart of our defense for two straight years," Keigen said. "He was simply a hard-nosed football player. He blocked well on offense as a tailback."

TROY HUDSON was asked to give up a job when he was moved from quarterback to wide receiver at Country Day. He was named First Team as a defensive back, but could play anywhere. Hudson had 11 touchdowns — two on punt returns — along with four interceptions. He had 23 tackles and 18 receptions on offense for 357 yards.

"Troy is the best and most versatile athlete in the school," D'Angelo said. "His teammates called him Anthony Carter because of his similarity to that athlete (the University of Michigan's All-American wide receiver)."

TODD KRUMM was a versatile

player for West Bloomfield. The 6-5, 185-pound junior safety will be the first four-year player for the Lakers. This season he rushed for 468 yards, caught 17 passes for 231 yards and scored six touchdowns. He averaged 35.3 yards on kickoff returns and had two returns for touchdowns. He also returned six punts for 59 yards.

"Todd has not lost touch with his classmates," coach Dom Livedoti said. "He has much God-given talent. He never misses a practice. He's a winner who will do anything for the best interest of the team."

MATT DINGENS was the second

leading tackler on the Brother Rice team with 60 individual tackles. The 6-6, 220-pounder also played linebacker and defensive end. He had 45 assists.

"Matt is valuable to our team because he can play any position on defense," Francis said. "He's a tremendous individual who any coach would want for a player."

COACH OF THE YEAR

John Herrington, the team's head behind Farmington Hills' success story, has coached his masters to two state championships in the past two years. In the process, the Hawks have

won 23 consecutive games. Herrington, in his 13 years at Harrison, has recorded a 94-31-1 record.

"The key to our success has been the stability of the program," Herrington explained. "I've got two varsity assistants (Bob Sutter and Bob Sallow) who've been with me for 10 years. Also, we have a winning tradition here, and that's important. The kids come in here believing they can win, and they do win."

Since Herrington led the Hawks to the Class-A state championship with Dave Blackmer as the only returning starter, it's frightening to think what he can do with John Miller back for two more years.

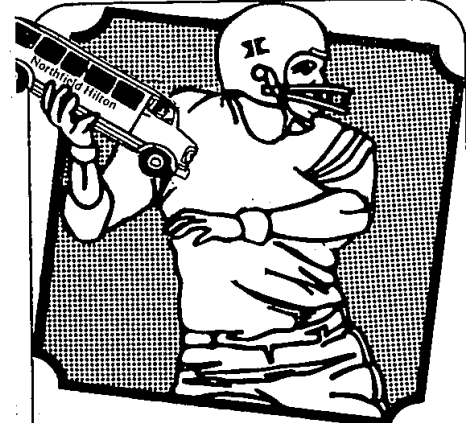
