

Hot glass studio reopens

Although the contemporary glass movement started in this part of the country, there are surprisingly few places in this metropolitan area offering classes in art glass.

Center for Creative Studies is one and now there is another.

The glass studio at the Birmingham Bloomfield Art Association, BBAA, is renovated, enlarged and ready for students. Classes start next week with glass artists/teachers Stuart Schuman and Albert Young.

Since October, the two have been at the glass studio, a small brick building directly behind the main building at the BBAA, fixing up and cleaning the original structure and adding a new section.

The original was once the domain of internationally-known glass artist, Richard Rittler.

ANOTHER leader in the contemporary glass field, Dale Chihuly, has already visited the new studio and signed his name on the glass pane of the front door.

All of the materials for the new wing, which measures about 15-by-20 feet, were donated. The majority of the tools which students will be using were donated by Habitat Galleries of Lathrup Village. The glass furnaces stay at 2,500 degrees and go 24 hours a day.

Schuman and Young have a rental arrangement with the BBAA. The studio

is theirs to use, providing they offer regular classes.

The series of 10-week classes, three hours each once a week, (by arriving early and staying late, students may stretch the three hours to five), will consist of six in a class. There are two glass furnaces, so two students may blow at a time.

In the beginning, both instructors will be on hand, so as Schuman pointed out, "We'll be working one on one while blowing."

Beginners, intermediates and advanced students are invited to enroll. Schuman and Young have set 48 as the maximum number they will be able to accommodate this term and a number of places are already filled.

COST FOR the 10-week class, \$190, covers all materials.

All aspects of hot-glass technique will be taught.

Schuman, a Detroit, attended Center for Creative Studies and graduated from Wayne State University in 1972 and has "been making art for a living ever since." He is both potter and glass artist.

Young, who lives in Farmington Hills, graduated from Center for Creative Studies last year, but was a studio potter before that.

Both artists participate in regional and local art invitational shows and gallery exhibits.
