**NOTICE OF A PUBLIC MEETING TO INSTITUTE A SUMMER PROPERTY TAX LEVY**

A public meeting of the Board of Education of the Clarenceville School District will be held:

Time: 8:00 p.m.  
Date: Thursday, January 27, 1983  
Place: Clarenceville Junior High School 20210 Middlebelt Road Livonia, Michigan 48152

The purpose of the meeting will be to determine whether to impose a summer property tax levy on the taxable property in the Clarenceville School District in order to receive school property taxes earlier during the school fiscal year and reduce or avoid interest costs on monies borrowed to operate the Clarenceville Schools. Under the applicable law of the State of Michigan collection may be either 1/4 or the total of the property tax levy for the school year to be due July with the remainder of the taxes, if any, due December 1. The resolution may be applicable until revoked or for levies in any year specified in the resolution. At present, the Clarenceville School District is collecting summer taxes in the portion of the District located in the City of Livonia and in the City of Farmington Hills under agreements with each city. This meeting will address the question of extending summer taxes to that portion of the District located in Redford Township.
