

## Theatre Guild Production: Veterans Appear As Old Couple

Two long-time members of the Livonia-Redford Theatre Guild have been "cast" as the aging couple in the group's production of "You Know I Can't Hear You When the Water's Running."

When the curtain goes up April 30 on the sophisticated comedy, "Water," the pair will appear in the segment entitled "I'm Hubert."

"Water" is actually four one-acts, all dealing with the general theme of sex and life.

The cast of "I'm Hubert" consists of a man, Hubert, and his wife, Muriel. All of the action takes place while they sit

in their garden in a pair of rocking chairs.

That means that the narrative is the "only" action, and everything depends on the timing and skill of the actors.

That's why two experienced actors have been cast in the roles.

The Guild cautions parents that this is a play designed for the mature audience and is not general family fare.
