Tips could save a life

With temperatures falling, surviving in the open water means not only saying afloat, but also coasterving body heat. The US. Coast Guard has complied some tips that could save your life in a Pocket Guide to Cold Water Survival." If you're involved in a cold-water accident, try to make your entry into the water gradual rather than abrupt. For example, stay with a sinking boat as long as there's anything left to hang onto, and keep as much of your body out of the water as possible.

A sudden pludge into ley water can send your breathing rate up uncontrollably, causing you to take water into your lungs. If there's no way to avoid a jump or fall, keep your elbows at your sides, cover your nose and mouth with one hand, and hold that wrist or elbow with the other hand. Once you're in the water, the danger of drowing is compounded by the threat of hypothermia — a condition where your body loses beat at its core, with effects ranging from numbness and disorientation to unconsciousness and death. To maintain body heat, you need to trap the small amount of water that's inside your clothing and let it warm up. So button up immediately. And don't swim any further than the closest object you can hang onto (swimming pumps the warmer water out of your clothes and lets colder water in).
