

Amateur swimmers to head for Orchard Ridge

The McDonald's 1983 Junior Olympic Swim Meet, one of Michigan's largest amateur sporting events, comes to Oakland Community College's Orchard Ridge Campus in Farmington Hills Saturday and Sunday, March 19-20.

The Michigan Stingray Swim Association, a metropolitan-Detroit amateur swimming club, will host the event, which is expected to attract more than 700 boys and girls, ages 8-18.

Some 50 amateur swimming organizations from throughout southeastern Michigan will be represented.

"This is a major state amateur swimming championship," said the Stingrays' George Kranz. "It will give

some of the state's finest young swimmers a taste of competitive swimming as a tune up for the 1984 Olympic swim trials."

McDonald's is the national sponsor of the Junior Olympic and Age Group programs conducted nationwide by United States Swimming, the governing body of amateur swimming in the United States.

McDonald's local restaurants will support more than 180 age-group swim meets across the nation, including the U.S. Swimming Junior Olympics between now and the 1984 Olympic Games in Los Angeles.

AT THE LOCAL meet, boys and girls will compete separately in five age-group classifications: 8 and under, 11-12, 13-14 and 15-18. Morning events will start at 8:45 a.m. and afternoon events at 1:45 p.m.

Among the awards presented will be a "McDonald's Olympic Spirit Award" at the meet's end to the team that demonstrates strong enthusiasm, dedication and good sportsmanship.

"This award will not necessarily go to the team with the most points," said Carol Koepke, the meet coordinator, "but rather to the team that exhibits the true Olympic winning spirit."

All participants will receive a "swim packet" containing the meet program, a certification of participation, a commemorative lapel pin and a finishing ribbon.

Proceeds from the meet will go to

the Stingray Swim Association. The Orchard Ridge Campus of OCC is on Orchard Lake Road between 11 and 12 Mile.
