WHAT DOES IT MEAN TO HAVE RHEUMATOID ARTHRITIS?

In rheumatoid arthritis the joints of the hands, wrists, elbows, shoulders, hips, knees, ankles and feet are affected with chronic inflammation. The disease is variable in its expression. At times all of the joints may be involved, at other times only one or two are painful. Rarely, irritation to the joints is so severe that no therapy can prevent the patient from being bedridden. For most people with rheumatoid arthritis their condition constantly shifts between the extremes noted above.

There are occasions when no joint appears inflamed, but the individual notes deep and continuing fatigue. This tiredness is not from depression but is part of the disease. At other times the individual is depressed; such feelings result from the inability to meet the expectations of others, or the disappointment of losing the ability to undertake activities independently.
