Nearly 250,000 infants are born with significant birth defects in this country each year. Some are born in Southfield.
 To provide Providence Hospital's patients and professional staff with the latest information about genetic disorders, birth defects and teratogens (agents which cause fetal abnormalities), a new service has been established.
 Genetic counseling and education is being provided by Lester Weiss, M.D., director of Henry Ford Hospital's Medical Genetics and Birth Defects center, and his team.
 According to the Don Krohn, M.D., chairman of the OB/GYN department at Providence, genetics is one of the most rapidly expanding fields in medicine.
 "New knowledge about genetic disorders, birth defects, fetal syndromes, their causes and the risk of recurrence is coming almost daily," Krohn says. "Our patients and staff must have as much information and support as we can give."
 To provide that support, Dr. Weiss and his group conduct an educational program for the professional staff during lectures, rounds, conferences and discussions.
 He is available for inpatient consultations in the nursery and on family care units. He also works with the staff and outpatients in the specialty clinics.
