FISHING FOR the pugoacinus sunfish family which in-cludes the bluegill and crappie, is good during spring. Taking these prolific characters in any size and great numbers has no bad effect upon their population.

During spring the spawning grounds in clear, gravel-bot-tom streams and among sparse grasses on flat, shallow edges of lakes are the best bets.

Later in the summer, when the sun becomes hot, these fish head for slightly deeper water, but will be easily found near weeds that reach nearly to or above the surface.
