Farmington Group Helps Make Books in Braille

FARMINGTON The blind who can read Braille are not disfranchised. The world of literature brings life to them. The problem is to have enough books translated into Braille.

A GROUP, working at Nardin Park United Methodist Church in Farmington is doing something about that. With Mrs. Carole Cramer of 33320 Lyneastle as chairman, 12 women have been working at the church for almost a year learning how to transcribe Braille.

The group meets in a church, but is non-denominational.

And it works totally on donations.

That means many donations because Braille writers cost \$100 each. The Farmington Lions Club has purchased two writers for the women. Eight others have been purchased from individual contributions and from silent auctions and similar events.

WHEN THE 12 women complete their program in September, they will be certified as Braille transcribers by the Library of Congress. They are taught by Mrs. Mary Begle, a certified teacher.

According to Mrs. Cramer, another class will be organized in September. Class size is limited to 12 and is open to any adult.

"You have to be an adult," says Mrs. Cramer, "because there is so much memory work. But the work is ideal for the young mother because she can transcribe books at home."

Persons interested in joining the class in September are invited to call Mrs. Cramer.

Drug Abuse Seminar Set

LIVONIA Homes throughout the Livonia and Clarenceville school districts are being covered this weekend with flyers advertising the day long drug abuse seminar scheduled for May 16 in the auditorium of Clarenceville High School.

Pastors of more than 40 churches have agreed to announce the meeting from their pulpits Sunday and to urge their congregations to attend. Copies of the flyer also will be placed in the churches for those attending to take home.

ABOUT 100 registrations have been made this far according to Glenn McAdam,

executive secretary for the Citizens Task Force Committee on Drug Abuse. The group hopes for an attendance of between 400 and 500.

Letters, signed by Livonia Mayor Edward H. McAmara and Westland Mayor Gene McKinney, have been mailed to more than 100 service organizations urging their support.

The flyers are going out from both public and parochial schools in the two districts.

The seminar is for persons in both school districts and the cities of Westland and Livonia.

Speakers will cover the drug

scene on the national, metropolitan and local drug scenes, and will cover legal and medical aspects of the narcotics problem. Youth will be drawn into the program in a panel entitled "Youth Speaks."
