Pays Dividend

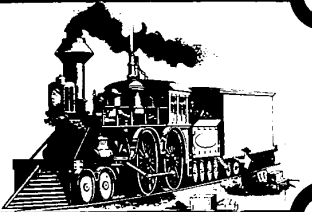
