Immunization fair Aug. 28

As an addition to its free health immunization program this month, the Detroit Health Department in cooperation with WXYZ-TV will hold a Children's Immunization Fair on Belle Isle Sunday, Aug. 28.

Free immunizations against the major childhood diseases will be given at the Belle Isle Casino from 10 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

Detroit area children who have not had their required immunizations brought up to date, especially those who are planning to enter school this fall, should be taken to the free fair by their parents or guardians, Dr. John B. Waller Jr., public health director, said.

Free immunizations provided at the fair will include diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis (whooping cough), measles, polio, rubella and mumps. State law requires that all children be immunized against these diseases before they can be admitted to school.

Parents who intend to bring their children to the Immunization Fair are urged to bring the child's immunization records. This will help speed up processing their children and obtaining the needed immunizations.
