## Quilts shine in playhouse setting

Be suspect if the crib quilt you see has a pattern that is as large as a full-size quilt, "Most of the crib quilts (like Knole Cottage) were scaled down." The patterns are the same, just smaller. The size, more conducive to displaying in today's more modest-sized apartments and condos, is one reason why the small quilts often cost more than large ones of comparable quality.

One of the rarest of the small quilts, "Delectable Mountains," is displayed in the front hall of Knole Cottage.
"This," said Silber, "is the earliest roller-printed chints we know of. Certainly, it is one of the earliest I have ever seen."
