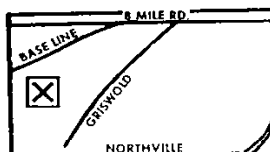

**Traveling With Tykes

Baby likes familiar things, so keep his schedule as normal as possible; bring along favorite toys...especially cuddly ones to sleep with...and foods that he likes best. If his feeding schedule is kept routine, travel will be more of a breeze. He may eat less than usual, but don't urge food on him that he doesn't want.

LIFE WILL BE SIMPLER if you carry all Baby's feeding equipment in one tote bag and keep that handy. For a small baby's formula, Ready-to-Feed Modilac is a great convenience.
