

Lincoln And Music Subjects By Petz

FARMINGTON
Weldon E. Petz, who has been connected with the Farmington school system for the last seven years and is now principal of the Forest Elementary School, will present a musical program at the monthly meeting of the Civil War Round Table of Michigan in Greenfield Village May 21, at 8 p.m.

His subject will be "The Musical Note in Abraham Lincoln's Life."

A native of Detroit, Petz earned three degrees at Wayne State University and worked as a professional musician in radio, the theater and the recording field in New York for four years before returning to Detroit to serve with the Detroit school system for 17 years. He came to the Farmington school system in 1963.

Petz has written many articles for history and Lincoln journals and magazines and has talked before more than 300 groups since he began his studies on Lincoln in 1943. He owns an extensive collection of Lincolniana.

His presentation will be given in Greenfield Village's Lovett Hall. The public is invited.
