She Witnessed Police Force



In the midst of this crowd were about 40 students staging a sit-in in the middle of the street.

As I approached, a bus filled with police officers drove up. The students were politely told to leave or they would be arrested. At this point several got up quietly and moved out of the street.

A long line of police officers then streamed off the bus, billy clubs in hand. Using two police officers for each student, even for the girls, they began to drag the students to the bus.

At first the students went willingly, either walking quietly or letting themselves go limp, but when the police officers began to drag them too roughly, twist arms and use strangle-holds on these students others now struggled.

At this point many in the crowd began to chant "pig" and "Heil Hitler" and probably some other choice epithets. Many of the officers now began to lose their cool.
