Thanks given in service

A special Thanksgiving service will begin at 10:30 a.m. Thursday in First Church of Christ, Scientist, 33825 Grand River in Farmington.

The service will begin with the reading of the President's Thanksgiving Proclamation, and includes Bible readings reflecting the Psalmist's gratitude even in the midst of his turbulent era: "How excellent is thy loving kindness, O God . . . the children of men put their trust under the shadow of thy wings. They shall be abundantly satisfied with the fatness of thy house; and thou shalt make them drink of the river of thy pleasures."

During the hourlong service, the readings will explore the scriptural record of God's loving kindness. Brief correlative passages from the Chris-
