"When people find out what their rights are, they are more condident. Tecnagers don't know their rights." But Judge Barry Grant, Oakland County Juvenile Court, says minors can't exercisor rights in evil cases without parental consent. No one under age 18 may obtain credit, write a will, fite a civil lawsuit, or sign contracts. Juvenile court handles caes involving youngsters, up to age 17, who commit criminal acts or are victures of child neglect and abuse.

"When a young offender goes into court, the judge tells him what his rights are."

But Wells says her aim is "preven-tion," by equipping teens for future le-

"SEXUAL HARRASSMENT is a situation that they don't know how to handle. Getting fired from a first job for something that you may not have done can be especially impressionable."

In one case she advised a client to take photographs of her apartment to help reclaim a security deposit.


