## Mercy sponsors stress seminar

"Crisis Intervention and Stress Management," a series of workshops for people who work with people, will be presented by Mercy College of Detroit's Office of Continuing Education beginning Wednesday.

The half-day sessions will be 8:30 a.m. until noon on four Wednesdays and are recommended for people who work in human services, health care, education, social work, counseling and law enforcement. Business people who interact with the general public and parents would also benefit from the workshops.

Wednesday's workshop will be on crisis intervention: how to de-escalate the crisis situation, how to problem-solve with the client and a step-by-step method for the effective resolution of the immediate crisis.

Deadline for registration for this session is Monday.

Management of the aggressive client or patient and how to reduce the potential for violence and diffuse the violent

situation will be discussed during the Dec. 7 session. Deadline for registration is Wednesday, Nov. 30.

THE TOPIC for the December 14th workshop is suicide assessment, prevention and counseling. How to assess who is suicidal, how high is the risk and strategies to help will be discussed. Registration deadline is Wednesday, Dec. 7.

How to manage stress effectively on the job and what to do with your stress as you help others in stressful situations will be the topic Jan. 4. Registration deadline is Tuesday, Dec. 20.

Fees for the sessions are \$25 each or \$80 for all four workshops. There is a 10-percent reduction in fees for groups of three or more.
