But a project, using community volunteers, may help plug some of the gaps created in these areas

"We are enthusiastic about this program," said Trustee Patricia Jackman and four other district representatives attended a three-day conference on volunteerism Oct. 30 through Nov. 2. "The schools are the most algnificant common bond that the people in our community have," she added.

In December 1981, the state Board of Education conducted a survey that revealed 76 spercent of the residents polled thought schools should use volunteers. Further, one of every three respondents said he would like to be a school volunteer.
