

Animals go to market

Among the many handmade works of art in the Detroit Artists Market holiday show are life size papier mache animals by Anita Flory of Beverly Hills.

Flory, a 1969 graduate of Groves High School, student of George Landino, has made all kinds of figures during her career, but the animals have caught on the most quickly. Along with the ram (not quite finished) and the goats is an assortment of cats and friendly looking pigs.

City eyes San Marino expansion

Available through the Michigan Department of Natural Resources, the \$105,000 grant from the Federal Land and Water Conservation Fund is to be used to buy five acres of property from the Farmington School District and to build a golf and parks maintenance facility. The building will replace the golf course's three deteriorating maintenance buildings.

"At this time, we believe the school district, the DNR and the city are lined up to proceed with the project," said Douglas Gaynor, director of special services.

Because it is a matching grant, city officials have reserved \$105,000 toward the project. Council members Monday authorized city staff to begin negotiating with the school district for the five acres abutting the golf course between 11 Mile and Halsted.

THE FIVE acres have already been appraised and a price of \$2,000 was tentatively agreed upon, Gaynor said in a report to the Farmington Hills City Council.

City officials will be interviewing architects needed to draw up plans for the proposed cinder block building. A new building is necessary because of inadequate storage facilities, poor condition of the existing

buildings and lack of security for golf and parks equipment, Gaynor said.

"A new maintenance facility will eliminate the necessity of the three buildings by incorporating working and storage areas under one roof and providing a safe, secured area for the staff and equipment," he added.

The proposed building will house the parts and golf maintenance operations as well as storage for maintenance equipment, fertilizer, chemicals and recreation equipment.

With the three existing buildings gone, a new driveway could be built which would allow increased parking.

Driving in darkness has additional rules

Night driving can be stressful, but that condition can be eased with some care. The Automotive Information Council (AIC) has compiled some tips relating to the car and to the driver.

It suggests that a driver sit in the car for a minute or two before starting to permit the eyes to adjust to darkness.

Don't look at the lights of on-coming cars, a practice that will change the focus of the eyes. Instead, look to the right of the lane marker or at the shoulder markings.

Don't wear colored glasses to avoid headlight glare. They reduce needed detail in night vision.

Watch your speed. Don't "over-drive" the distance you can see.

Regarding the car, make sure the headlights and tail lights are clean. Under adverse weather conditions, stop frequently to clean dirt, ice or snow from the lights.

The inside surface of the windshield should be clean to avoid distortion from on-coming headlights. This is especially important in summer if you have a plastic dashboard. Deposits from smoke attract moisture and increase distortion and glare.

WINDSHIELD WIPERS should be able to clean the windshield without leaving streaks or smears, which can hamper vision.



ON A LONG trip, keep alert by moving the eyes, hands and legs and take occasional rest stops to reduce eye and body fatigue.
