STATE NEWS IN BRIEF

Detroit—Nearly \$18,000 in checks taken in the holdup of the Walker Advertising company pay car, recently, has been recovered, together with the bandits' car.

Lansing—A 13-year-old girl and her mother were killed and two others were seriously injured, when an automobile and a truck collided at Sager's corners, north of Lansing.

Port Huron—An order received by F. E. Morse, local agent for the Detroit, Bay City and Western railroad, was to the effect that all passenger, mail and express service be discontinued.

Lansing—A state-wide quarantine of circuses, state fairs and carnivals, has been ordered by Dr. M. C. Olin, state health commissioner, until the quarantine is lifted.

Grand Rapids—The Grand Rapids, Holland and Chicago Railway Company, operating electric lines south and west out of Grand Rapids, has been placed in the hands of a receiver in United States district court.

Lansing—The construction of a concrete wall, capable of enclosing a complete new prison plant, on the north farm at Jackson prison, was authorized by the state prison commission, meeting. An appropriation of \$300,000 for the purpose is available.
