Host Families Needed For Exchange Students

FARMINGTON Youth For Understanding, teenage exchange program based in Ann Arbor, is now accepting applications in the Farmington Area for host families.

Young people will be arriving in August and early September from South America, Europe and Asian countries.

SOME WILL STAY for eight weeks, some for the complete school year and others will arrive in February for one semester.

Application to host an exchange student can be made

by contacting Mrs. Wesley Orr, Jr., area chairman, at 26508 Farmington Rd., or Mr. and Mrs. Glen Mingo, Farmington chairmen, at 29531 Pipers Lane.

Presently, more than 14 YFU exchange students are living in the Farmington Area and attending area high schools.

"The requirements to serve as a host family are few," says Mrs. Orr, "but the benefits are beyond description."

FAMILIES ARE being sought who live within the attendance boundaries of Farmington Senior High. North

Farmington High, Our Lady of Sorrows, Our Lady of Mercy, Clarenceville and Redford Unions.

Tuition and many other considerations are taken care of for the students, making it easier for a family to add one more member. Host families need not have a teenager to qualify.

Early applicants will have a greater choice of the students coming this summer. Mrs. Orr and the Mingos also process applications for American students wishing to go abroad.
