Childbirth Classes Set

The Childbirth Preparation Association announced starting dates for a new series of classes in the method of childbirth being held in four locations.

The series will start in Wyandotte on June 24 at Wyandotte General Hospital; in Taylor on June 22 at Southminster United Presbyterian Church; in Wayne on July 2 at First United Methodist Church; and in Trenton on July 9 at Seaway Hospital.

Registered nurses instruct the classes which meet one night a week for six weeks. Women are advised to begin the classes at least eight weeks before their due dates.

Subject matter in the classes includes an explanation of labor and birth and instructions on neuromuscular control and effective breathing techniques which will enable the mother to be awake and participating in the birth of her child.

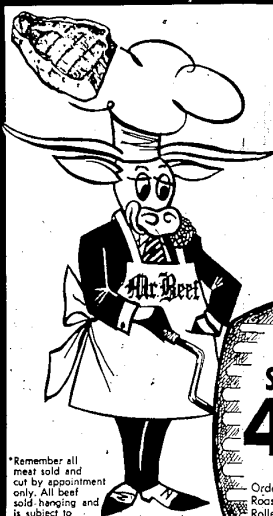
