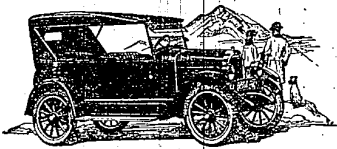

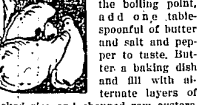

SEASONABLE FOODS

Before the oyster season is over try: Oysters With Rice—Bring a pint of oysters to the boiling point...



Veal and Celery Soup—Cut up a dozen stalks celery, cook until tender in salted water with a small onion sliced, then press through a sieve...

Chefing Crackers—Mix together three tablespoons of grated cheese, one-fourth teaspoonful of dry mustard, one teaspoonful of anchovy paste, a dash of cayenne and a tablespoonful of salt...

Roast Beef With Currant Jelly—Place one-fourth of a pound of butter with half a glass of jelly in a chafin dish. When well heated add thin slices of cold roast beef...

Cream Dressing for Fruit Salad—Melt four tablespoonfuls of butter, add two and one-half tablespoonfuls of cornstarch, one tablespoonful of flour, one-fourth teaspoonful of salt...

Chesse Cones—To two cups of mashed potato add one cupful of grated chesse, season with salt and pepper, and mold in an ice cream spoon...

Jellied Beef—Soft one-fourth of a package of gelatin in one-fourth cupful of cold water and dissolve by setting into a dish of hot water...

Things We Like—This cake recipe has been given before but is a great favorite when eggs are scarce and high...

Apple Sauce Cake—Cream one-half cupful of butter, add one cupful of sugar gradually, one and one-half cups of apple sauce strained and sweetened...

Caramel Cream Pie—Take two-thirds of a cupful of sugar, add three tablespoonfuls of softened butter, one-half cupful of sweet milk...

Filling for Caramel Pie—Beat one cupful of sugar by stirring until melted in an iron frying pan. Add the sugar when a golden brown strip to one cupful of milk...
