District Judge William Bolle last
Monday granted a motion for the forensic exam, which was requested by
Buckley's lawyer, Walter Meyers.

Preliminary exam — to determine that a crime was committed and there's probable cause that Buckley committed the crime — has been post-poned pending psychiatric testing.

By law, the avaluation must be completed within 60 days.
Meyers declined to comment on how Buckley is reacting to his aituation and what the basic thrust of a legal defense

Buckley, already arraigned on an open murder charge, has been held without bond in the Oakland County Jail since Dec. 29. Meyers speculated Monday that Buckley would be transferred for testing within a few days.

BUCKLEY allegedly stabbed and

slashed his wife, Elaine, 37, repeatedly with a knife during an argument short-ly after Mrs. Buckley arrived home from work.

Mrs. Buckley was an office manager for the Lambrecht Realty Co. Death was attributed to shock and hemor-rhage due to multiple stab wounds, said an investigator for the Oakland County Medical Examiner.

A neighbor called police after being alerted to the attack by the couple's daughter, Denise, 17, police said.

Denise told police the argument between her parents moved to a bedroom, where she beard her mother scream. Denise reportedly observed her father with a knife in his hand before she field, police said.

Joseph Buckley was arrested in the house by police without a struggle. A knife believed to be the murder weapon was recovered at the scene. Elaine Buckley died in William Beaumont Hospital in Royal Oak about 7½ bours after she was stabbed.
