New firefighters join Hills force

Nineteen new recruit firefighters have joined the Farmington Hills Fire Department after successfully completing a required 66-hour training course.

The department now will have approximately 80 firefighters, including 11 full time. That works out to about 20 firefighters at each of the city's four fire stations.

The fire department is able to offer the 66-hour class because it has state certified instructors and coordinators, who are responsible for developing the required training course.

The class covers basic firefighters' training, including use of trucks, ladders and other equipment, as well as basic first aid and cardiopulmonary resuscitation. Within the next few weeks, the department will offer an advanced first aid course for firefighters.

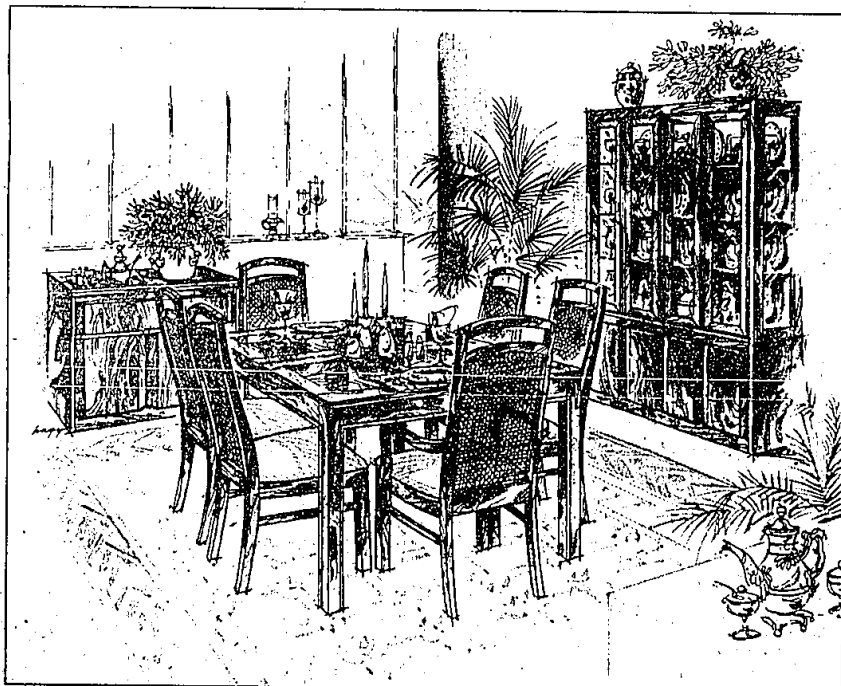

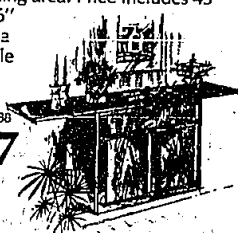
