

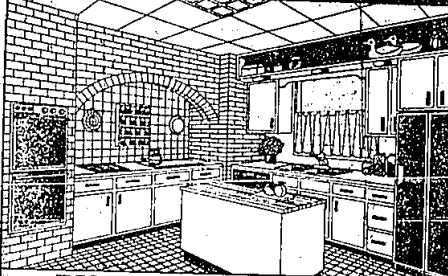
YMCA highlights
