

# Falcons fad in 4th quarter

Livonia Stevenson broke open a tight basketball game with a 27-9 outburst in the final period to beat Farmington, 63-39, in a Western Lakes encounter Tuesday night.

Tom Domako, a 6-foot-8 senior, led the Spartans with 27 points and 17 rebounds.

The Spartans, who were down the Falcons inside, also got eight points each from 6-6 junior Bob Sluka and 6-5 senior Steve Russo.

Tim Carruthers topped Farmington with 20 points.

The loss leaves the Falcons 3-10 overall and 1-8 in the Western Lakes Stevenson.

meanwhile, is 9-3 and 6-3.

"We succeeded with the offense," said Stevenson coach George Van Wagoner. "Even though Farmington hasn't had that good of a year, we still have to execute."

JOHN GLENN '71, HARRISON '65: Junior guard Mike Baydarian scored 18 points to lead the Rockets to a non-league win Tuesday night.

Mario Grazzula, a 6-6 senior, added 15 points and Jeff Hawley contributed 13. Don Ward also came off the score nine.

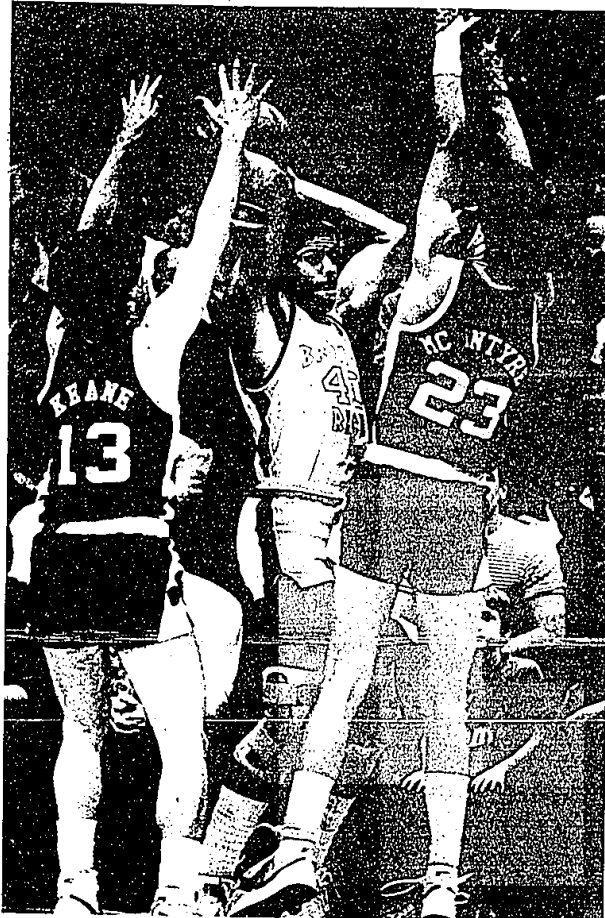
Senior forward Dave Quarles paced Harrison with 21 points. Senior guard Dave

Younger chipped in with 18 points and seven assists, while senior forward Ron Karbowski scored 10.

Glenn won the game by outscoring the Hawks 14-10 in the third quarter and by making 9-of-13 free throws in the final period.

"We had three fast-breaks turned into turnovers in the third quarter," said Harrison coach Mike Teachman, citing the loss. "We had five turnovers in that quarter and only 13 for the game."

Glenn is now 7-5 overall, while Harrison slipped to 3-9.

## Avenged CC hangs on to upend Rice

Detroit Catholic Central basketball coach Bernie Holowicki took a big gamble against Birmingham Brother Rice Tuesday, and it paid off as the Shamrocks stunned the state's No. 5-ranked Warriors, 53-50.

Leading 25-23 at halftime, Holowicki decided to start sharpshooting guard John McIntyre in the second half, though the talented junior was saddled with four personal fouls.

McIntyre responded by pumping in 12 of his game-high 25 points in the third quarter to give the Shamrocks a 42-31 lead before fouling out with 1:33 left in the quarter.

Rice came back strong late in the game, but it was the classic too little, too late, and host CC escaped with the upset as elated fans poured onto the court in celebration.

"WE DECIDED at halftime to go with McIntyre," Holowicki said. "It was a gamble, but we figured there was no waiting — we had to look at the game positively."

Holowicki credited his team for holding on against Rice in the final quarter, though it looked like the bigger and stronger Warriors were going to come back and steal the win.

"We lucked out," he said. "The tide was turning in their favor and we almost wavered, but we managed to hold on."

"We played them hard and smart, and we battled them on the boards," he added. "It was a big win — we needed it."

Rice looked like it would blow the Shamrocks out of their own gym at the start after jumping to an early 8-2 lead.

BUT THE SHAMROCKS, led by McIntyre's seven unanswered points, came back to knot the score at 13-13 by the end of the quarter.

The lead seasawed in the second quarter, but CC,

thanks to its tenacious full-court press, finally took control, taking a 25-23 lead into the locker room.

After Rice's disastrous third quarter, the Warriors staged a comeback in the final eight minutes. Led by slick junior guard B.J. Armstrong's nine points, Rice pulled to within a point, 47-46, with three minutes left.

But the Shamrocks combination of a slow down offense and some clutch free throw shooting down the stretch sealed the victory.

"We weren't ready to play — that's the bottom line," Rice coach Nick Conti said. "Having beaten them (CC) five times in the past three years caused us to lose sight of what these games mean to the two schools."

"THIS WAS THE least prepared team I've ever put on the floor against CC," he added. "Our players didn't believe they could lose. Well, they learned the hard way."

For McIntyre, it was another in a series of outstanding games this season.

The 6-foot-3 guard, who scored 42 points in last Friday's 61-58 win over Harper Woods Bishop Gallagher, hit 11 of 21 shots against Rice, mostly from "downcourt." He was also credited with four steals and five assists.

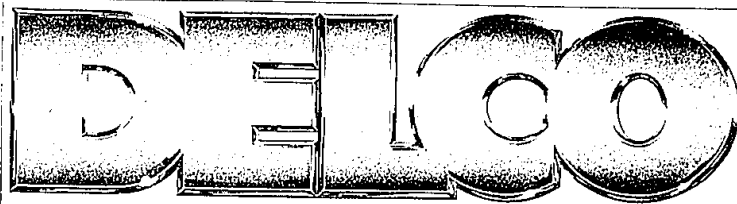
Junior forward Ron Wandzel pitched in 12 points, including two free throws that put CC ahead 53-48 with only 20 seconds left. Center Paul Tavara blocked six shots and added nine points. Freshman Tom Goodwin played well coming off the bench.

B.J. Armstrong led Rice with 19 points and Andy Kelp contributed 13.

Rice outrebounded CC, 31-26, but the Shamrocks outshot the Warriors, connecting on 20 of 41 (48 percent), compared to 21 of 59 (35 percent).

The win gives CC's Central Division record at 4-4. It stands 6-7 overall.

Rice, meanwhile, drops to 7-1 in league, 11-2 overall.
