FREEDMAN SAID he hopes the cable TV venture will receive additional financial support from MetroVIsion and the cable commission "just as other (school) districts throughout the state have received support.

But Freedman added, "At this point in time, we have not received any statement of support in terms of finances or equipment."

The Southfield School District, Freedman said, recently received a \$544,102 grant from their cable compa-




