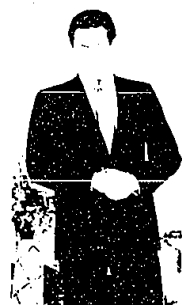

editing room cutting and rearranging the film to improve on the show's continuity."

Now that the money for needed equipment is available, Bunnell said, he expects the television production class size will increase. The class size has been limited to six or seven students because of the uncertainty of equipment funding. The class also was a late addition to the class catalogue, so few students had a chance to add it to their schedule, Bunnell said.

As interest grows, Bunnell is anticipating adding an advanced course in

television production. The goal is to have trained students on hand to film school activities which will be aired on Channel 35, which is available to Continental subscribers.

Southfield-Lathrup High School already has a television studio and Southfield High School operates an FM radio station. Under the grant, Southfield-Lathrup will receive \$110,000 of editing and production equipment, \$30,000 will go for personnel and the rest will go toward connecting the system and equipment in other schools.
