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"I would ask the council not to accept this motion," Dudley said, referring to the letter. She

added that residents should "take this opportunity as a very good learning experience."

Alkateb, however, chided Dudley for her comments adding that residents do not go to council meetings to be reprimanded or educated.

"I apologize," Dudley told Glen Oaks residents. "I didn't mean to chastise you."

Although Williams said "what Mrs. Dudley says makes sense," he later voted to send the letter to MORC.

Councilwoman Jodi Soronen agreed in sending the letter, because "I don't see the need that you have to put two homes with mentally retarded people in one small subdivision."

Dolan, on the other hand, said, "I understand why the state took this (group home placement) away from the hands of the local community."

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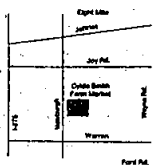
